Membership of Rothley Community Library is easy and free, you just need to register your name, address and email. As a member of the charitable association, you will have a vote at the AGM when your committee comes up for re-election, and a monthly email newsletter letting you know what's happening at the library. This is about supporting your local library and the voluntary organisation which runs it. There's no membership card. Children can become members too, with their parents' permission, though they won't be able to stand for election or vote at an AGM until they are 16.

To borrow books, you will need to be a member of Leicestershire Libraries. You can join at any county library or online, you will be given a library card, and you can use your card to access the services of any county library, including Rothley's.

Membership helps by showing local people's support for the library. The information you provide will be held in the strictest confidence, and will not be released to any other organisation.
